

The information herein is extracted from the Armed Violence Monitoring Platform (AVMP) (http://www.seesac.org/AVMP/) showing the main data on the reported firearm-related incidents in South East Europe covering Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Republic of Moldova and Serbia, as collected from media reports, for the period from 1 to 30 November 2019.


As per media clippings, a total of **147** firearm-related incidents that took place in the region were recorded on the AVMP.

Types of incidents




Almost every fifth firearm-related incident was committed in criminal context (30).

Perpetrators

Total number of perpetrators was **148**, of whom **147** were men and **1** was woman.*

woman.





Victims

In all incidents in November, the total number of victims was **75**. In the incidents for which the sex of the victims was reported, **56** were men and **15** were women.




Outcome for Victims

No firearm-related victims were reported in the Republic of Moldova this month.



Out of 56 men who were threatened, injured or killed in a firearm-related incidents, the highest number was recorded in Serbia, totalling 17.
