Objectives

- Examine the feasibility to link registries within a beneficiary and across borders.
- The registries could include lawfully possessed, lost/stolen, recovered, forensic examination, & imported/exported
- Standardise data sets, marking (import) & if appropriate deactivation standard.
- Facilitate the production of intelligence for action, rather than the production of statistical reports.

standard background enquiry checks for applicants

standard catalogue for firearm descriptions

permit formats

forensic procedures and techniques

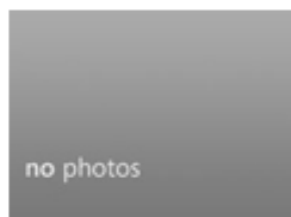
