Legislation governing control over the circulation of small arms and light weapons in the Republic of Belarus

***Law** of the Republic of Belarus, 13 November, 2001 No. 61 «On arms»;*

***Decree** of the President of the Republic of Belarus, 30 August, 2002 No. 473 «On measures to improve the regulation of the circulation of military, official, civilian weapons and ammunition in the territory of the Republic of Belarus»;*

***Decree** of the President of the Republic of Belarus, 4 April, 2003 No. 134 «On some issues of arms trafficking on the territory of the Republic of Belarus»;*

***Decree** of the President of the Republic of Belarus, 1 September, 2010 No. 450 «On licensing certain types of activities» (Chapter 30 of the Decree defines activities related to official and civilian weapons and ammunition, collecting and exhibiting weapons and ammunition);*

***Decree** of the President of the Republic of Belarus, 24 August, 2017 No. 302 «On the circulation of weapons»*
