Secondary

Directives: Do not aim at unifying, but rather harmonize in a way that the diversity of national institutions and legal structures may continue, on the account that there is a guarantee that throughout the Union minimum equal conditions exist

Regulations are instruments of unification

Decisions are binding directly in the same way as regulations but only apply to those to whom they are addressed

Recommendations and opinions are non binding legal acts



Forth request: Regional Harmonization Standard

Aim



Besides the transposition process at individual jurisdiction level, it was also requested to come to an agreed level of regional harmonization so that:



there do not occur legal loopholes that can be exploited by criminals or criminal groups;



that there should not occur obstacles for joint investigations; and



that there is common understanding of definitions used in the region.

Provided with a clear, permanent and unique mark

Registered without delay after manufacture

Unique mark



Marking of elementary package of ammunition



Unique marking at tie of transfer from military to permanent civilian market



Registration, licensing and authorisation of dealers and brokers

Records 30 years
