Military storages

Law enforcement storages:

- Own equipment
- Seized

Agency for confiscation of assets

Legal entities;

- Producers of fireworks;
- Producers of Ammunition
- Producers of anti hail rockets
- Dealers/Retail of Ammunition, black powder and pyrotechnics

# LE storages

## Formation weapons

- Unit storage: Rudimentary conditions

## Evidence Rooms:

- Very often a mix of different materials
- In Urban areas
- In or nearby police station ( If any)

# Legal entities

Producers: Some in inhabited areas

Retail: small amount in inhabited areas

Weapons: recent attacks and robberies of particular weapons even with high security measures in place

# Challenges

Coordination between relevant ministry who owns the storage and local governance regarding issuance of building permits which could have a direct impact on ELL and max NEQ to be stored.

Very often changes in urban planning

Mentality of : “It will not happen!”

Dense populated areas

Issue with criminal procedure code and keeping on too large amount of unsafe ammunition or explosives for a long time.

Way ahead

Amendment law on weapons and Secondary legislation on production, storage and retail shops – CRITERIA

- Including mandatory coordination with Local Government

New law on explosives for civil use including pyrotechnic materials

- Including mandatory coordination with Local Government

Immediately Field visit expert to all storage locations under control of MoIA : LE and civilian and **development of ELL and follow up inspections periodically**

Guidelines on SOP per civilian site and implementation of SOP on storages for MoI and relevant institutions

Training Inspectors

Inspection schedules and inspection reports
