Key features:

- Amnesty-based programme;
- Multiple stakeholders intervention (international, civil protection, police, CSO);
- Awareness raising, collection and registration;
- Based on modified MRE concept through community-based policing;
- Collective incentive approach;
- Turning weapons into products for peaceful purposes.



SPREADING AWARENESS

COMMUNITY-BASED APPROACH

 Comprehensive package – info points in the city centers, radio jingles, TV shows/interviews, NGO discussions, media advisory/press release...







WEAPONS COLLECTION



- Call 122;
- Weapons are collected by unmarked and civilian attire Mol and Civil Protection teams;
- Weapons are inspected, registered, controlled and prepared for destruction;



DESTRUCTION




- 136,000 pieces of weapons;
- 15,000,000 pieces of SALW ammo;
- 5,500 pieces of weapons;
- Over 200,000 pieces of munitions.
