
Legislative Framework

Kosovo Forensic Agency Portable Laboratory / Bullet Recovery System






 Bullet recovery system arrived and training will take place week of 21 July 2014.

 - Operation against celebratory fire


SALW Collection

 - Issues: Is part of the regional project supported by EC through SEESAC
 - Until now 522 weapons,
 - Pristina has a list of 1301 weapons to be destroyed – Follow up prosecutor
