## Main principles

- ISACS standards and the Regional Micro-Disarmament Standards
- Combined use of the quantitative and qualitative methods
- Field survey
- Sample size 1300 respondents

#### The Assesment uses:

- Survey
- Indirect calculation
- Evaluation of key informants
- Official statistics

 Quantitative research is supplemented by focus groups and analysis of media

#### **STRUCTURE**

- Contextual analysis
- Distribution analysis
- Impact survey
- Perception survey

#### **METHODOLOGY**

- Quantitive (field survey with households)
- Qualitative (focus groups)
- Combination of the two (content analysis, incl. media)

### THE QUESTIONNAIRE

- 36 QUESTIONS: demographic ones; the perception of safety; local community; society and weapons; weapons collection actions; and the posession of weapons.
- The accent is on the perception of safety and the posession of weapons.
- Increase of anonymity and reformulation of questions

## Back to reality...

- National Commission at its meeting in February 2014 decided to postpone the execution of the survey
- Mol recognized certain improvements to the 2006 survey but still the assessment was that there is no enough added value
- Interesting discussion point on the posession of weapons and security
