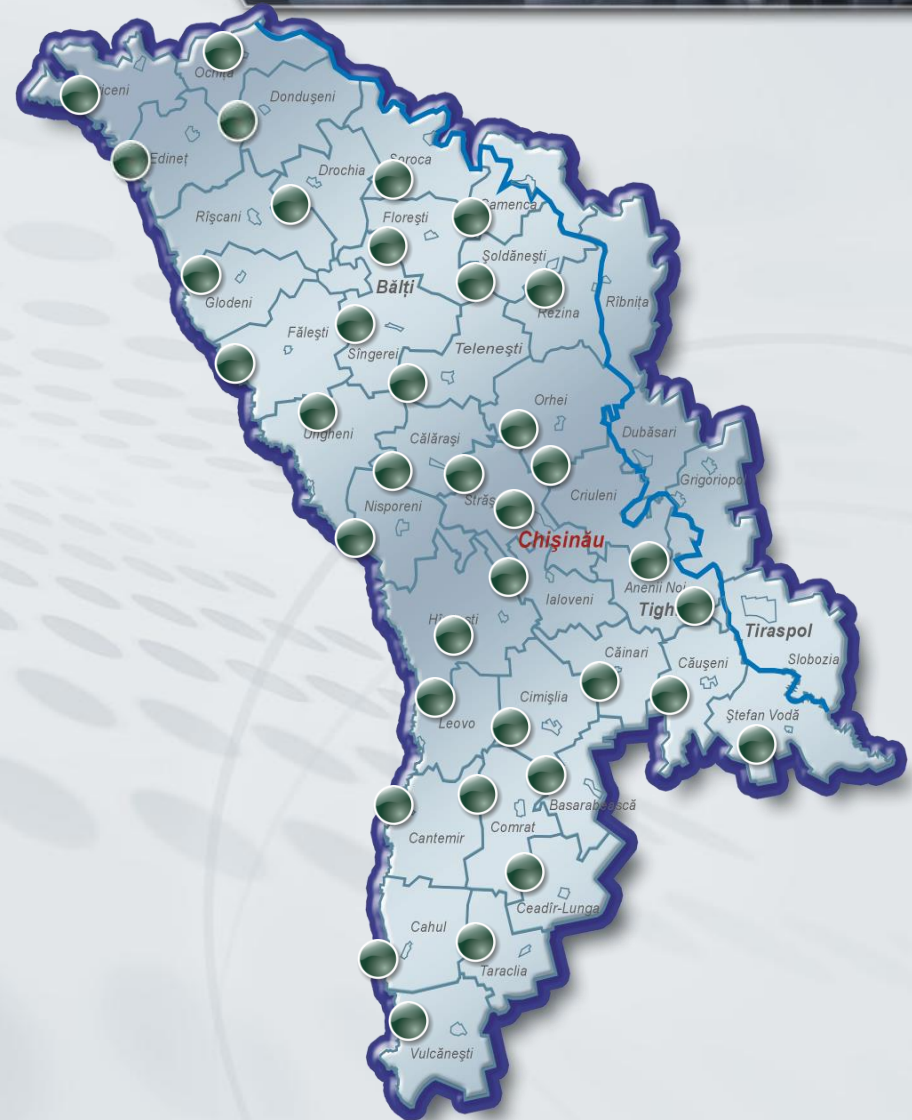
NORMATIVE FRAMEWORK

- Law No. 130 from 08.06.2012 concerning the regime of weapons and ammunition with civil destination;
- Government Decision No. 293 from 23.04.2014 approving the Regulation on the regime of weapons and ammunition with civil destination;
- Decision No. 634 from 06.06.2007 approving the Concept of Automated Information System "State Register of Arms".

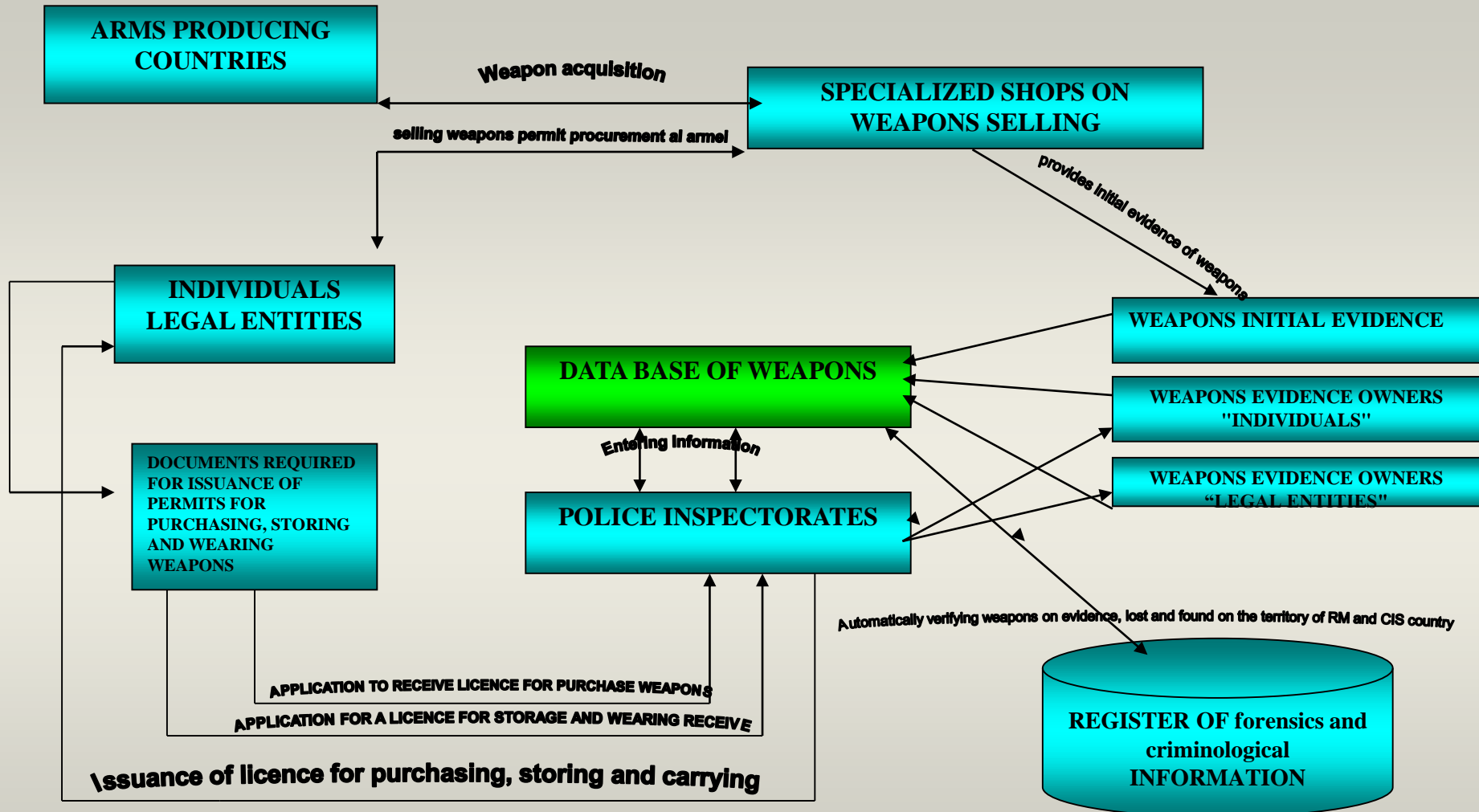
STATE ARMS REGISTER

Implemented from 01.01.2013

1. 100% of territorial Police Inspectorates connected online (VPN);
2. The establishment of unified accounting and centralized system of weapons with civil destination from individuals and legal entities possession;
3. Integration in the system of the subdivisions of the Ministry of Internal Affairs responsible for the prevention and combating of crimes that allows accessing data on weapons and their owners in online regime;
4. Connecting licensed dealers in the import and sale of weapons, so that weapons introduced in the country of import are included in "State Arms Register," then exposed to commercialization;
5. Permanent monitoring of the circuit until the stage of physical destruction of weapons;
6. Archiving and storage of data about all previous owners of weapons;
7. Data security and protection of personal data of the owners of weapons.

Marking weapons

- *Regulated in the art. 49 (Marking of products gunsmiths weapons and ammunition from Moldova) of the Law. 130 from 08.06.2012 concerning the status of weapons and ammunition for civil destination, which establishes the following :*
 - *Alin. (1) Dealers licensed to produce weapons and / or ammunition are obliged, in the manufacturing process, to apply on arms and ammunition identification markings.*
 - *Alin. (2) Markings in alin. (1) must include the following elements:*
 - a) Indicative of the country Republic of Moldova;*
 - b) indicative of the dealer that it produces;*
 - c) indicative of the appropriate category set out in Appendix. 1 of the law of which the weapon or caliber ammunition;*
 - d) year of manufacturing of weapons and ammunition, the serial number of each weapon, set for each category of those recorded in the Appendix. 1 of the Law.*
- *According to Government Decision no. 293 of 04/23/2014, it was established that the stamp on imported weapons in Republic of Moldova consists of two capital letters - the last two digits of the MD and the year in which imported weapon, application of which is provided by the importer.*
