

The information herein is extracted from the Armed Violence Monitoring Platform (AVMP) (http://www.seesac.org/AVMP/) showing the main data on the reported firearm-related incidents in South East Europe covering Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Republic of Moldova and Serbia, as collected from media reports, for the period from 1 to 30 November 2020.


As per media clippings, a total of **272** firearm-related incidents that took place in the region were recorded on the AVMP.**



*References to Kosovo shall be understood to be in the context of Security Council Resolution 1244 (1999).


**The information provided in this report is based on the AVMP data extracted on 10 December 2020.

Types of incidents



Perpetrators*


The total number of perpetrators was **320**. In incidents for which the sex of the perpetrator was reported, **226** were men and **3** were women.*



^{*} Refers only to incidents for which the number and sex of the perpetrators was reported.


Victims*

In all incidents in November, the total number of victims was **121**. In the incidents for which the sex of the victims was reported, **80** were men and **37** were women.




*Victim refers to any individual who has been threatened, injured or died as a result of the use of a firearm.

Outcome for Victims




^{*}Not applicable refers to all incidents in which a firearm was present but was not discharged nor used for inflicting injuries and threatening (for example, a theft of a firearm).

Relationship between victims and perpetrators




Type of weapon
