

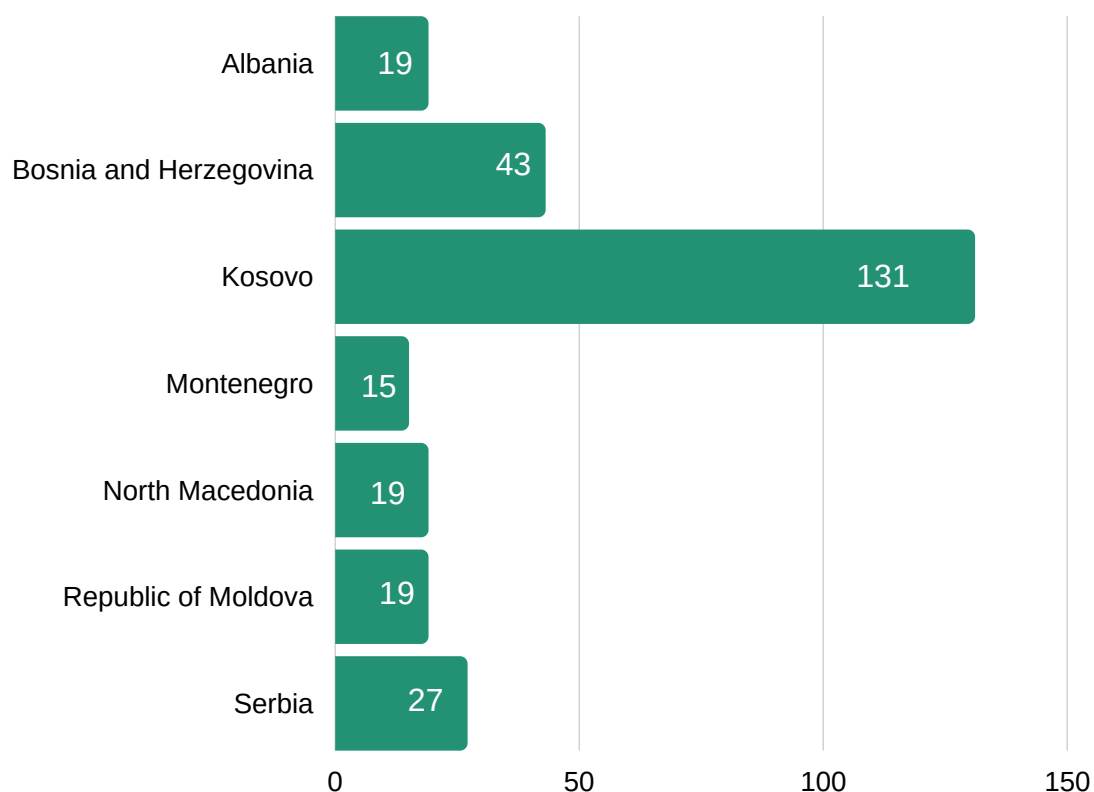

The information herein is extracted from the Armed Violence Monitoring Platform (AVMP) (<http://www.seesac.org/AVMP/>) showing the main data on the reported firearm-related incidents in South East Europe covering Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo\*, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Republic of Moldova and Serbia, as collected from media reports, for the period from 1 to 31 October 2020.

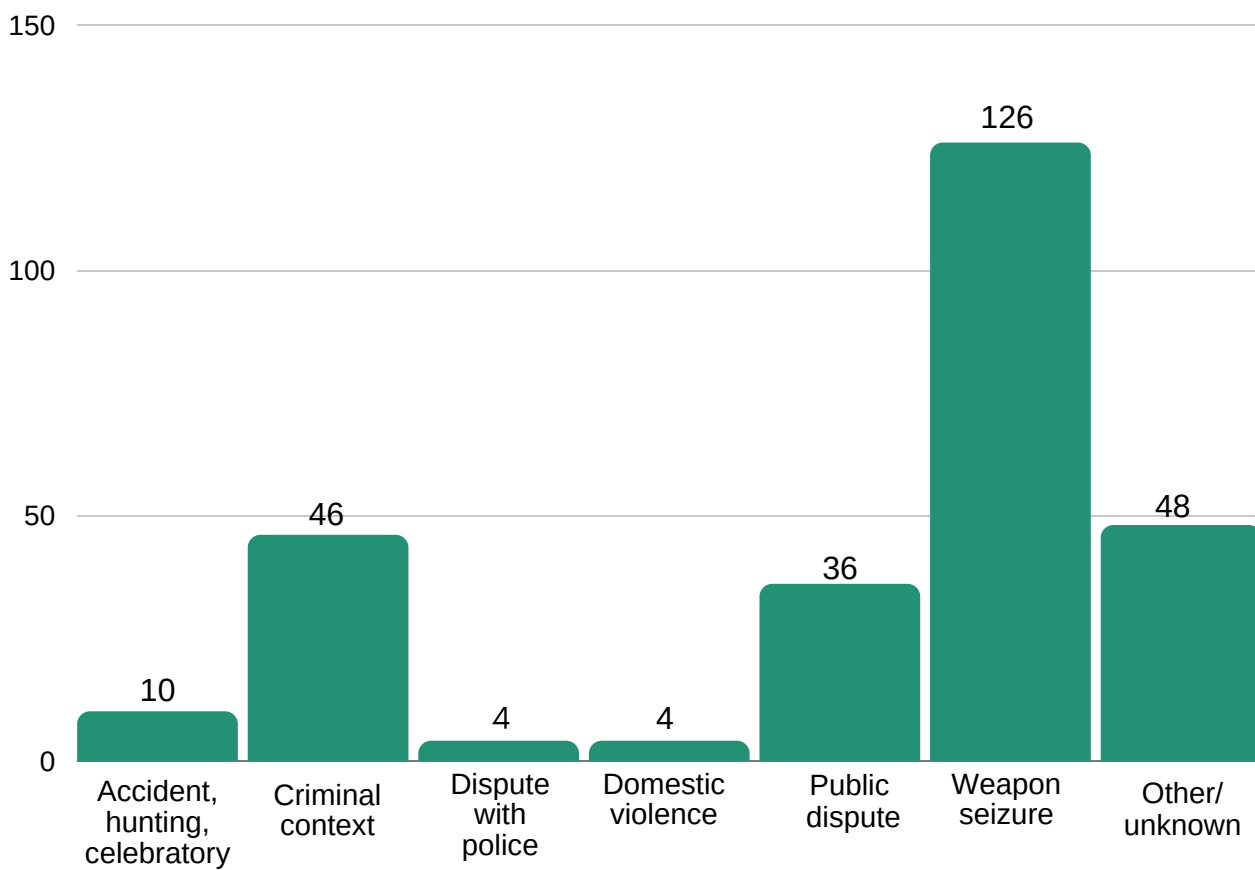
As per media clippings, a total of **274** firearm-related incidents that took place in the region were recorded on the AVMP.\*\*



*\*References to Kosovo shall be understood to be in the context of Security Council Resolution 1244 (1999).*

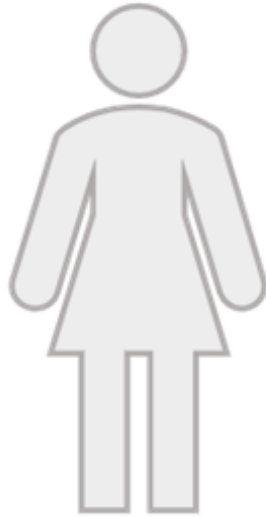

# Perpetrators\*

Total number of perpetrators was **338**. In incidents for which the sex of the perpetrator was reported, **208** were men and **6** were women.\*

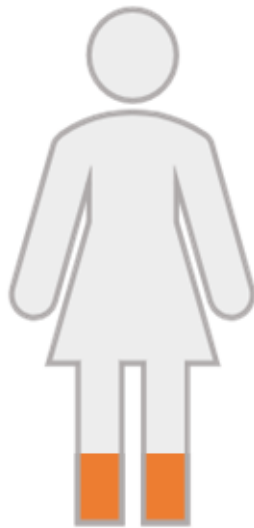

In all incidents in October, the total number of victims was **111**. In the incidents for which the sex of the victims was reported, **92** were men and **17** were women.

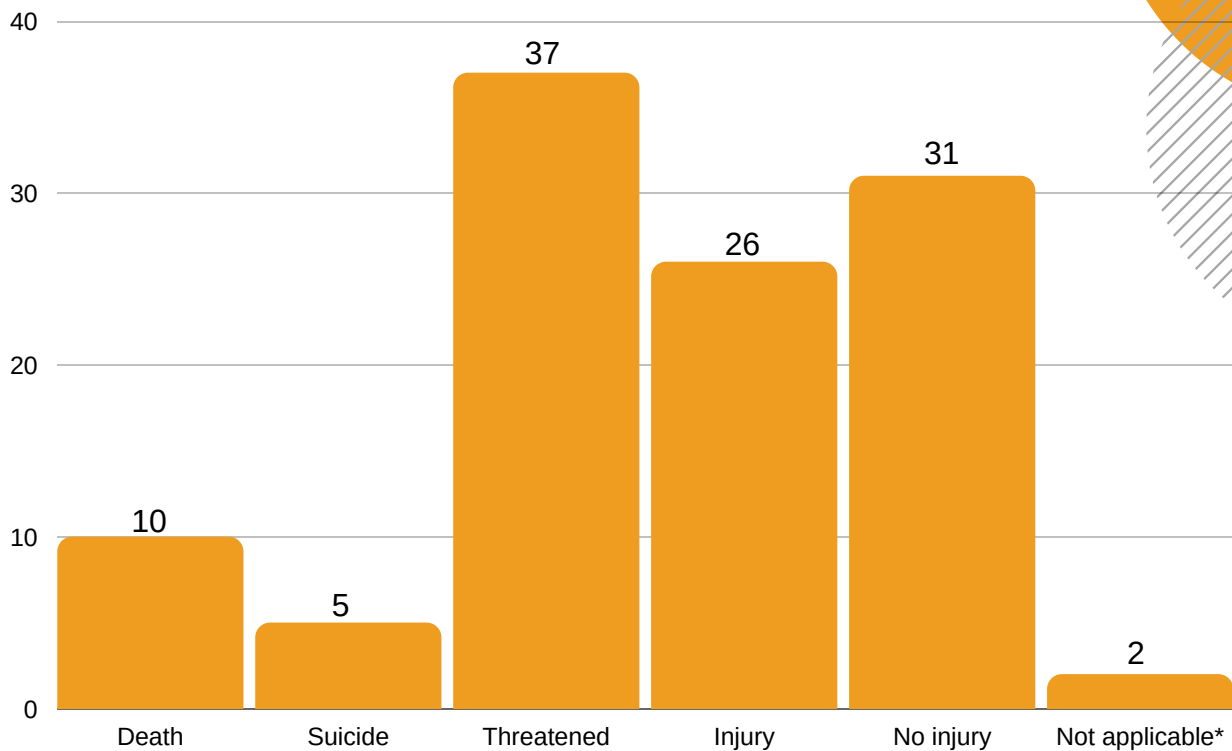

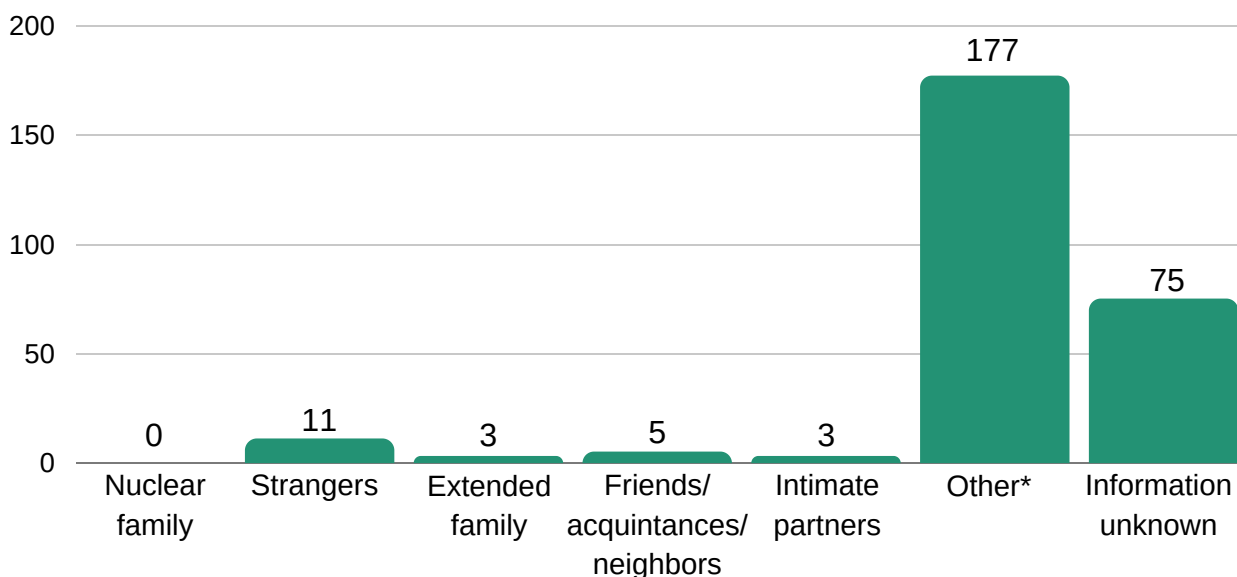
*\*Victim refers to any individual who has been threatened, injured or died as a result of the use of a firearm.*

# Outcome for Victims



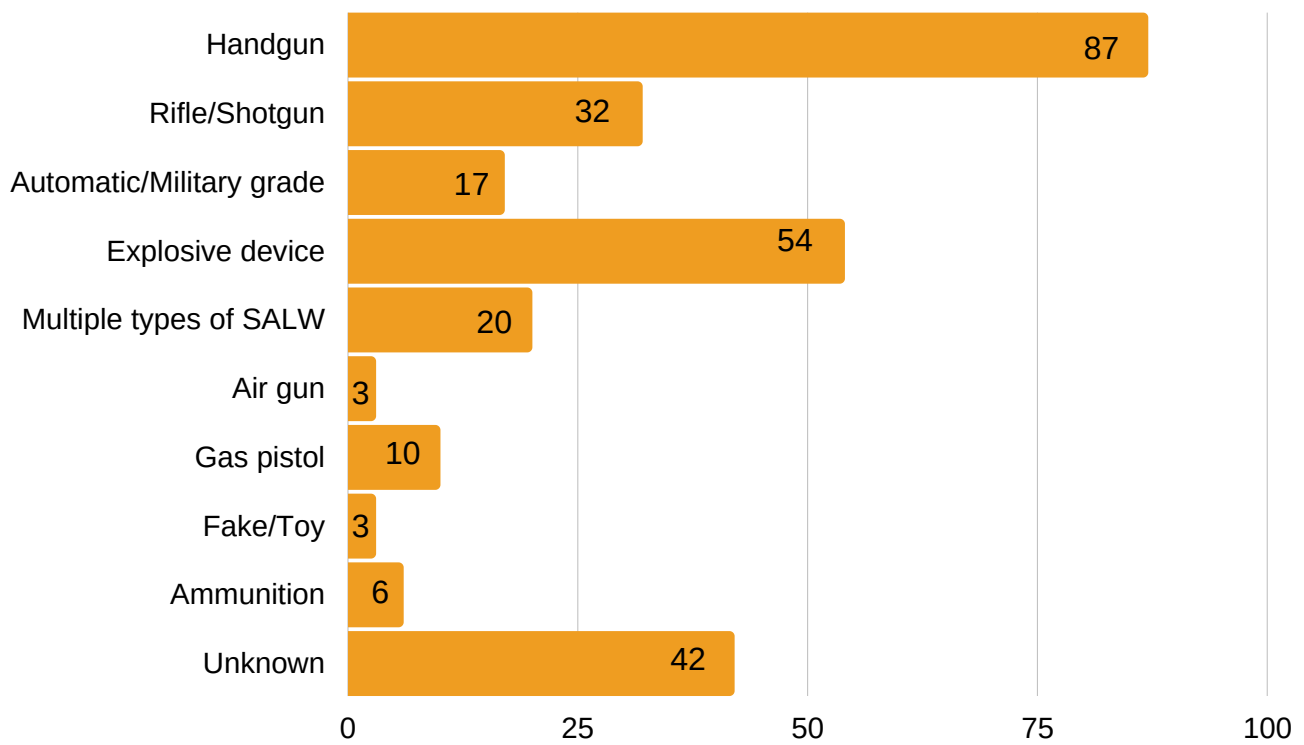
*\*Not applicable refers to all incidents in which a firearm was present but was not discharged nor used for inflicting injuries and threatening (for example, a theft of a firearm).*

# Relationship between victims and perpetrators

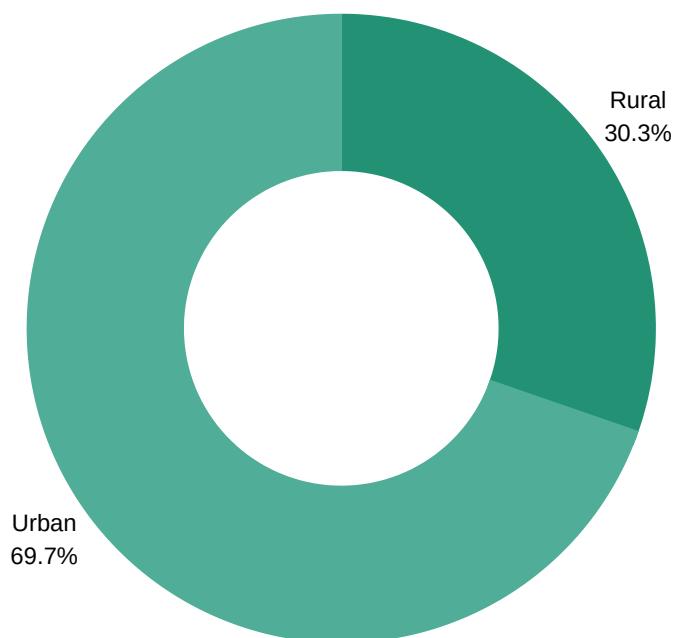

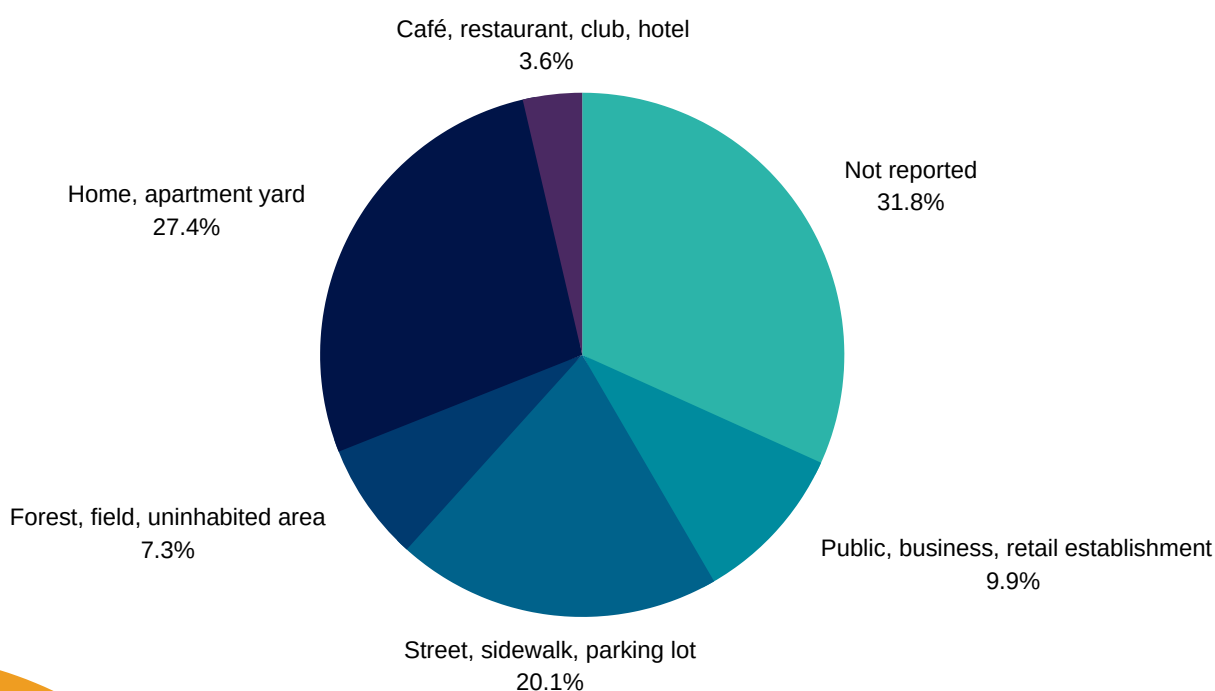
# Type of weapon
