

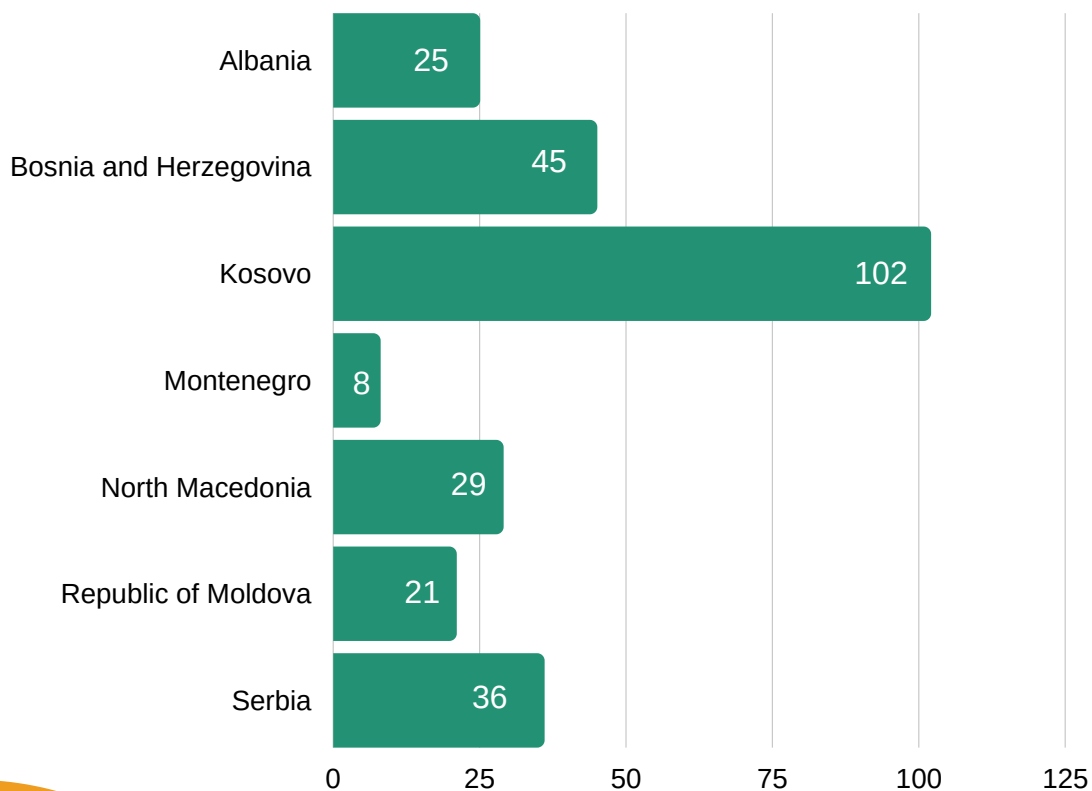

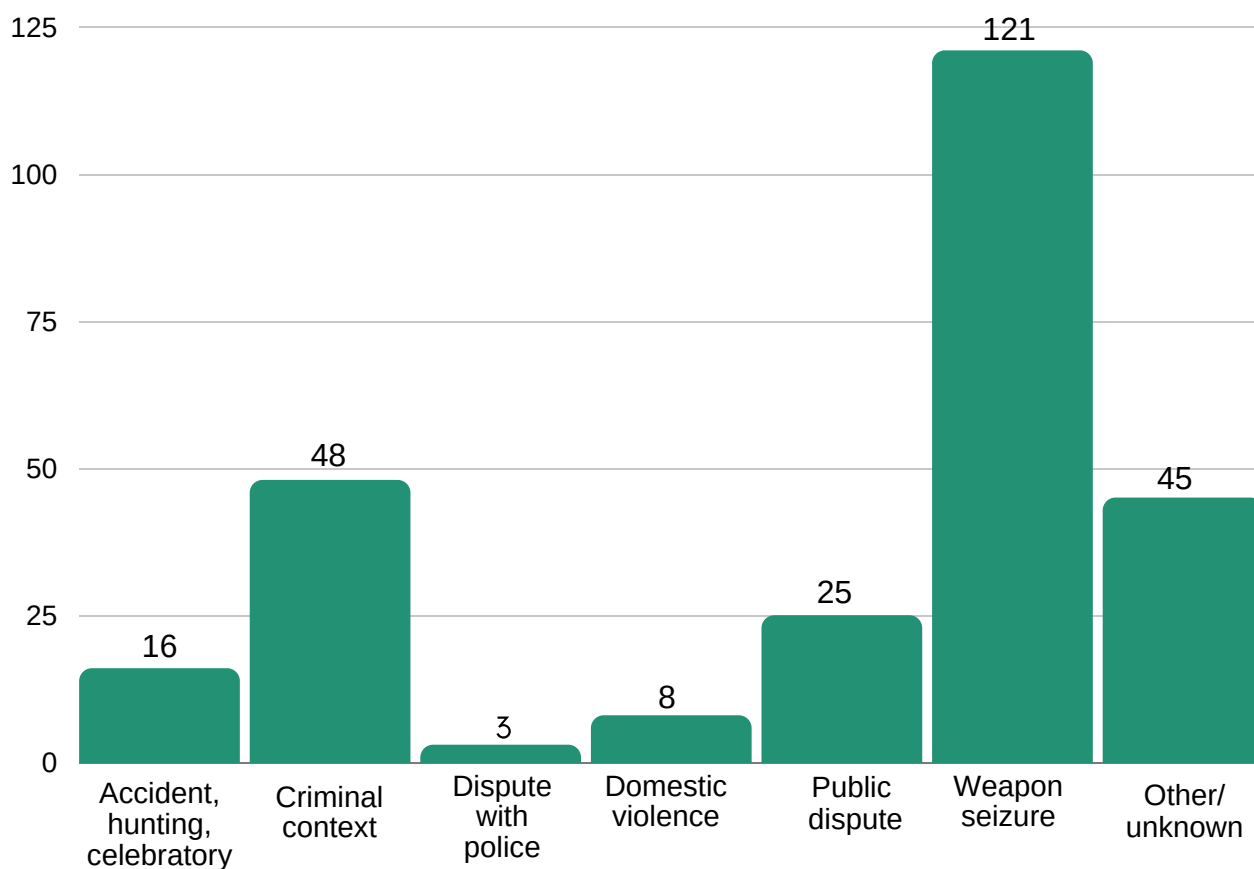
The information herein is extracted from the Armed Violence Monitoring Platform (AVMP) (<http://www.seesac.org/AVMP/>) showing the main data on the reported firearm-related incidents in South East Europe covering Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Republic of Moldova and Serbia, as collected from media reports, for the period from 1 to 30 September 2020.

As per media clippings, a total of **266** firearm-related incidents that took place in the region were recorded on the AVMP.



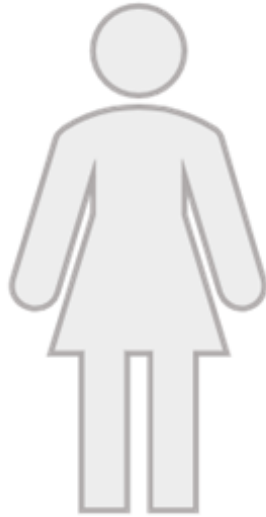
**References to Kosovo shall be understood to be in the context of Security Council Resolution 1244 (1999).*

Types of incidents



Perpetrators*

Total number of perpetrators was **335**. In incidents for which the sex of the perpetrator was reported, **256** were men and **7** were women.*

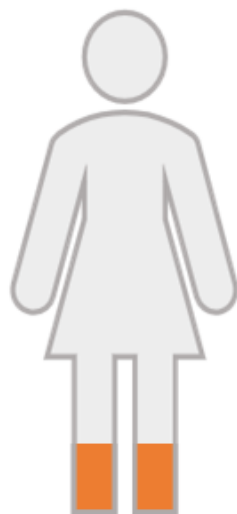

Victims*

In all incidents in September, the total number of victims was **107**. In the incidents for which the sex of the victims was reported, **83** were men and **16** were women.

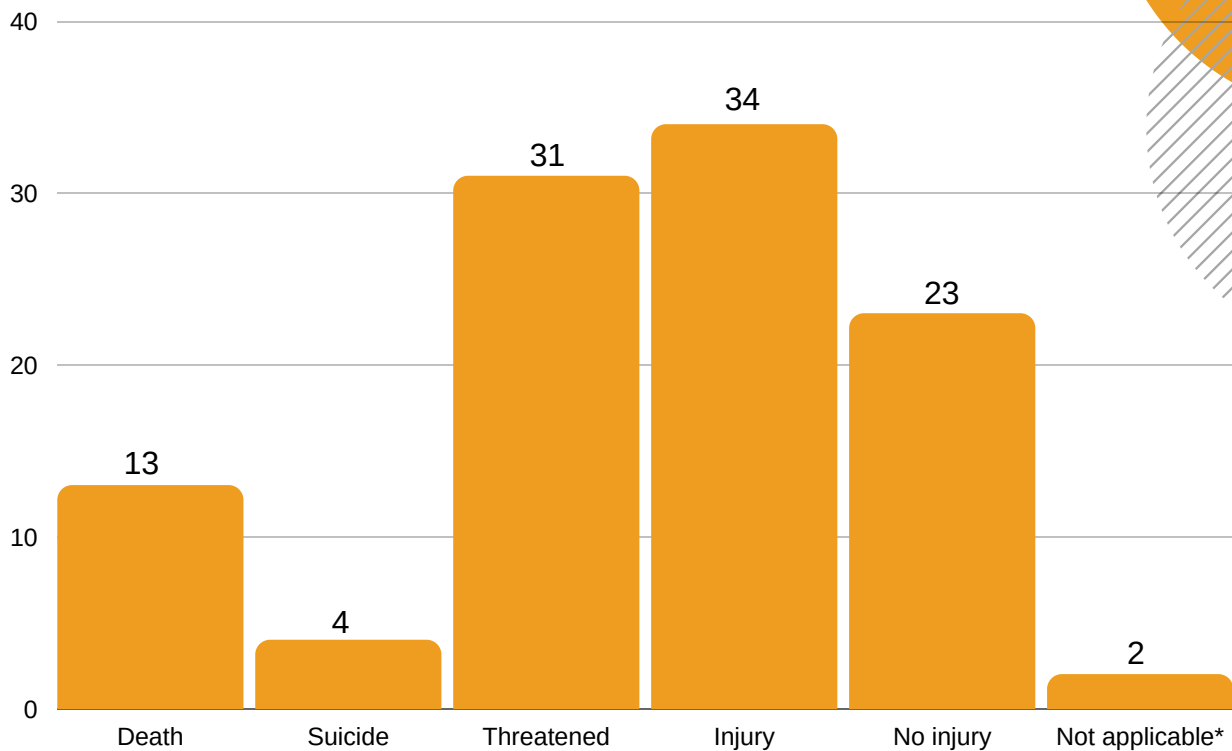

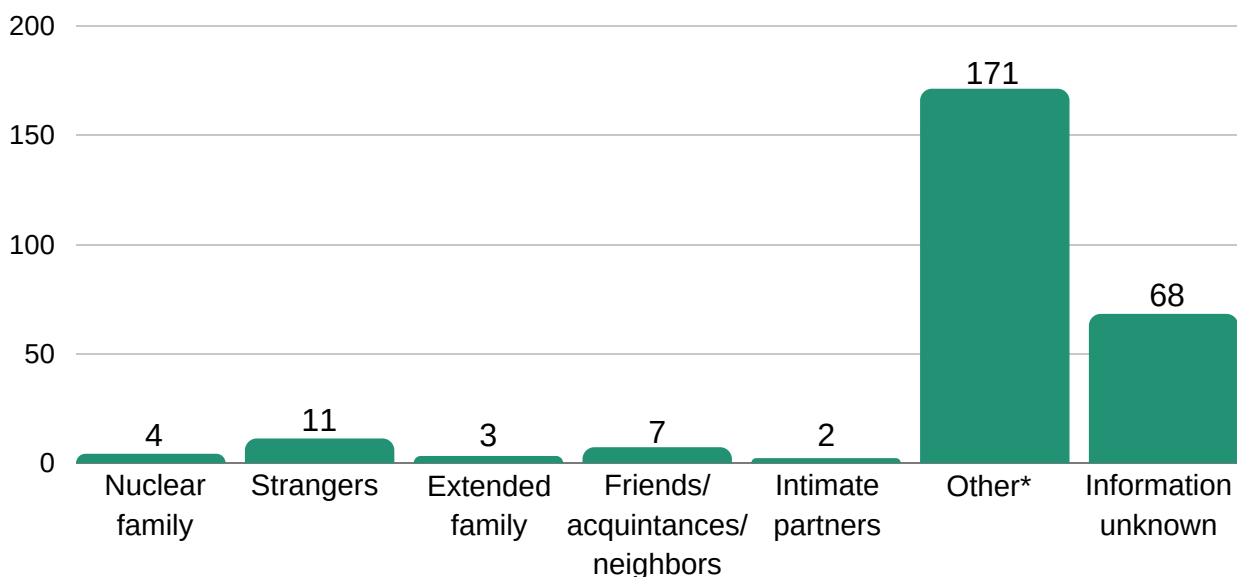
**Victim refers to any individual who has been threatened, injured or died as a result of the use of a firearm.*

Outcome for Victims



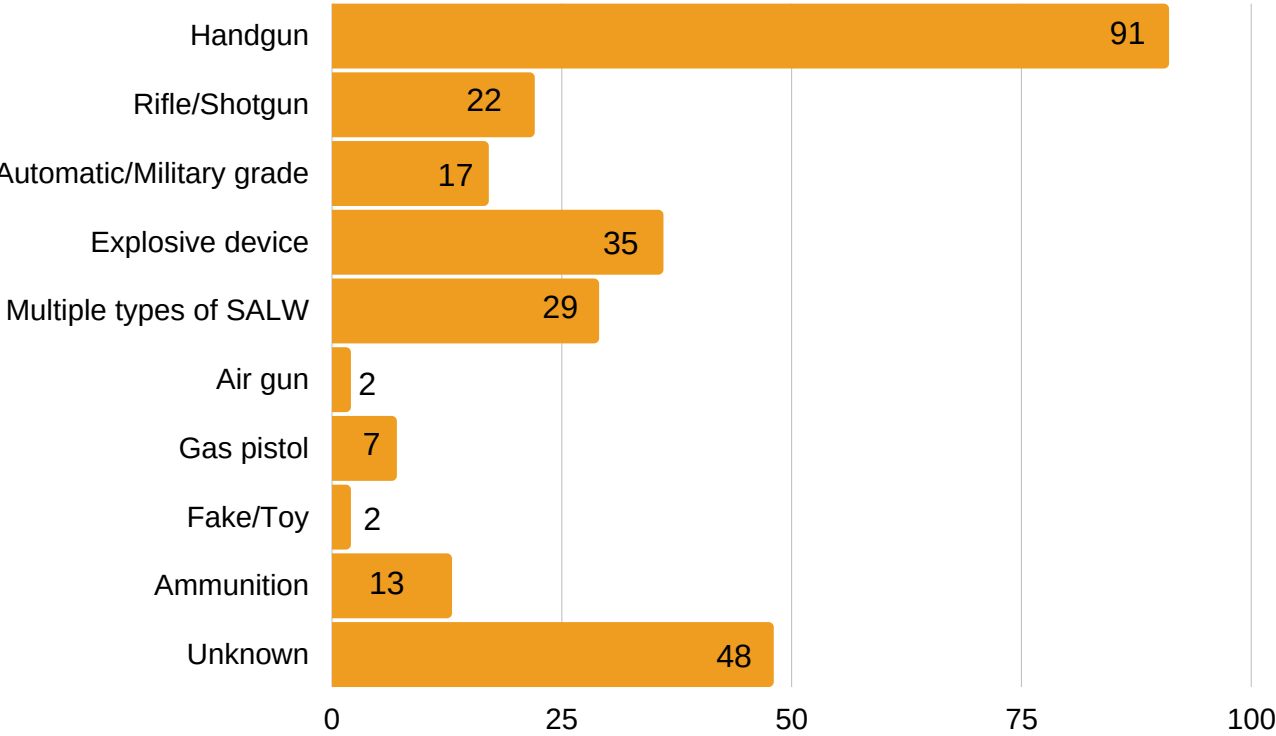
**Not applicable refers to all incidents in which a firearm was present but was not discharged nor used for inflicting injuries and threatening (for example, a theft of a firearm).*

Relationship between victims and perpetrators

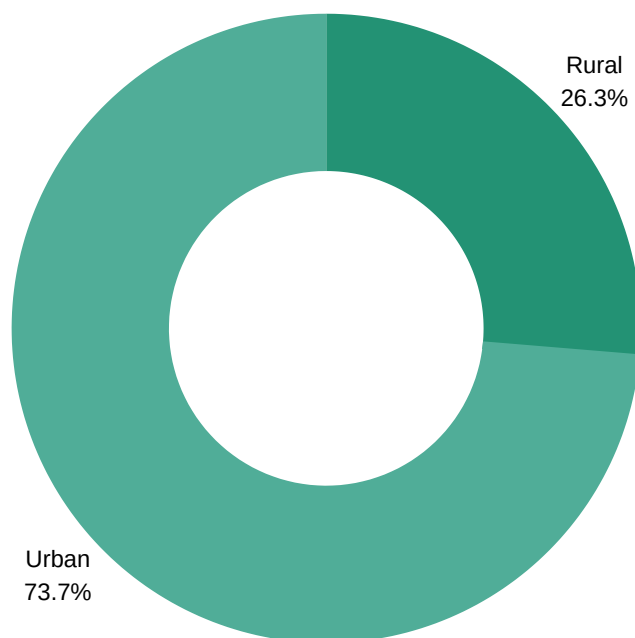
