

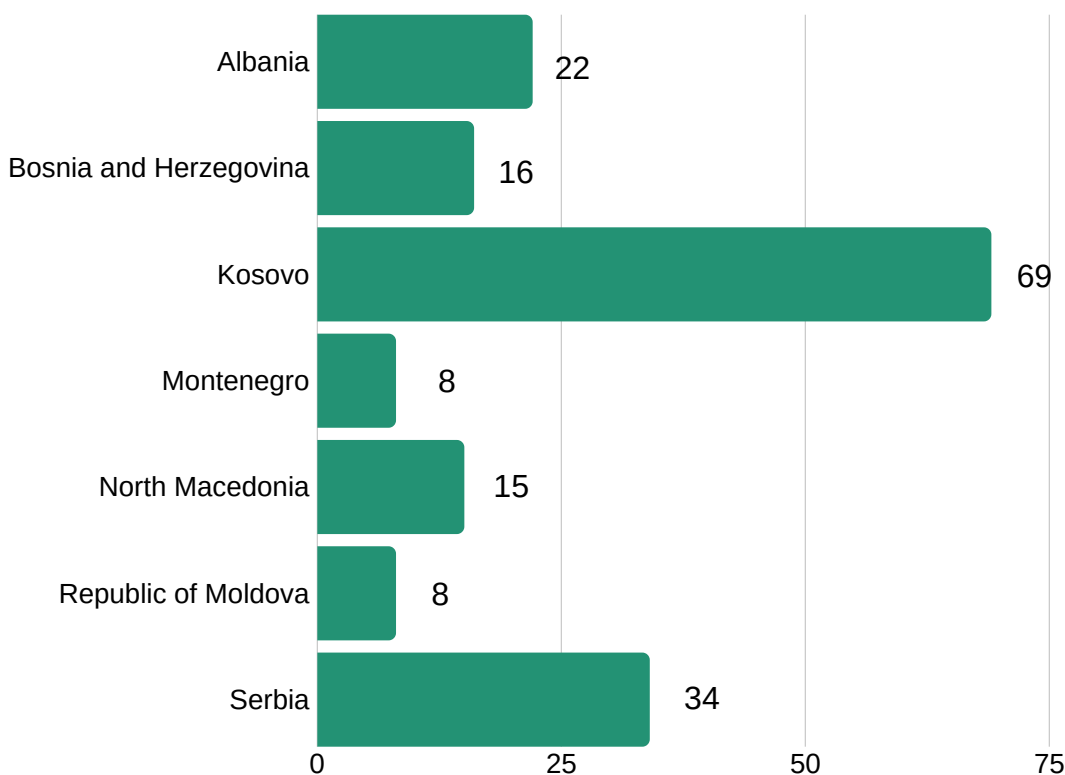

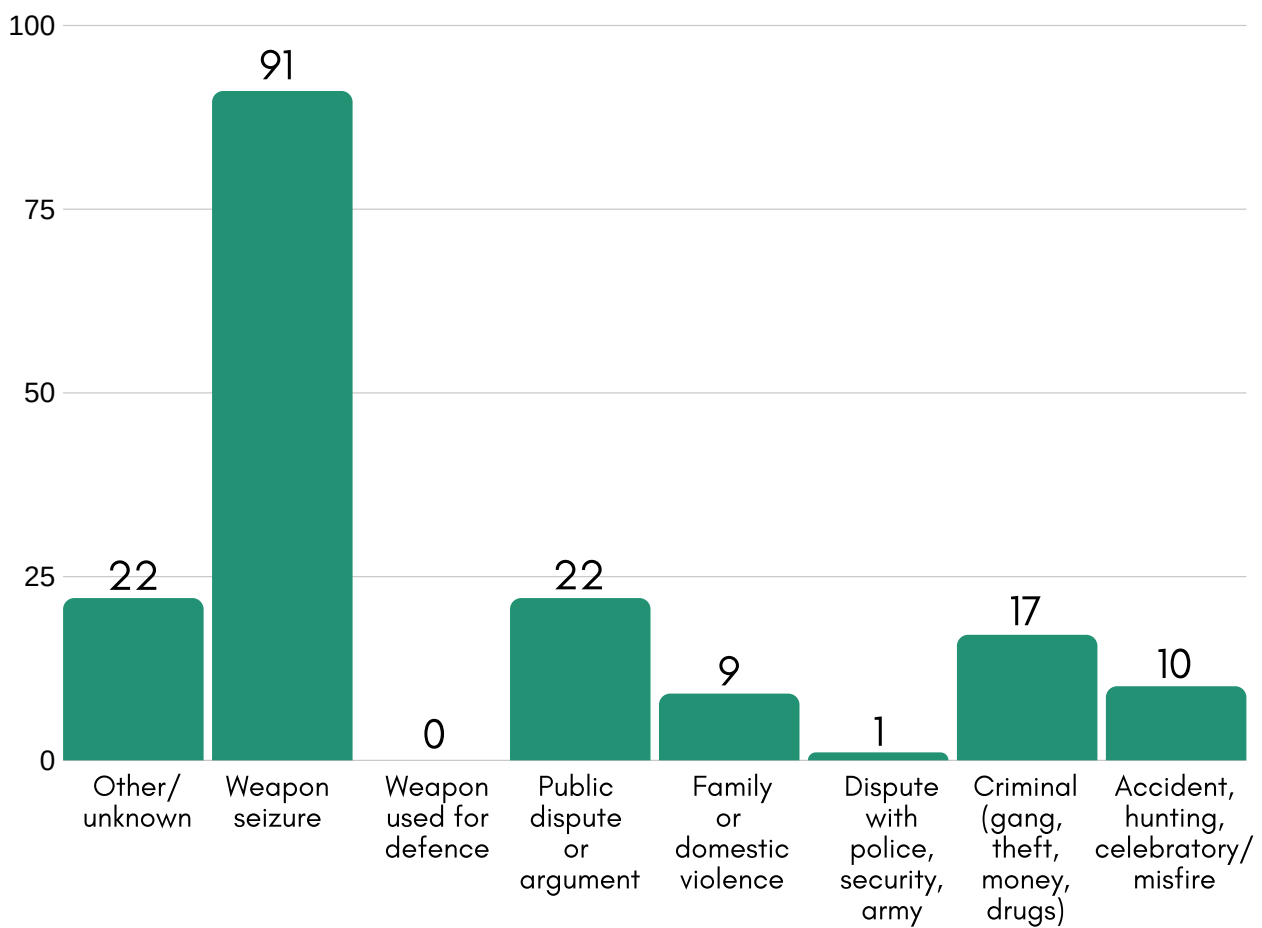
The information herein is extracted from the Armed Violence Monitoring Platform (AVMP) (<http://www.seesac.org/AVMP/>) showing the main data on the reported firearm-related incidents in South East Europe covering Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo\*, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Republic of Moldova and Serbia, as collected from media reports, for the period from 1 to 30 September 2019.

As per media clippings, a total of **172** firearm-related incidents that took place in the region were recorded on the AVMP.



\*References to Kosovo shall be understood to be in the context of Security Council Resolution 1244 (1999).

# Perpetrators

Total number of perpetrators was **191**, of whom **187** were men and **4** were women.\*

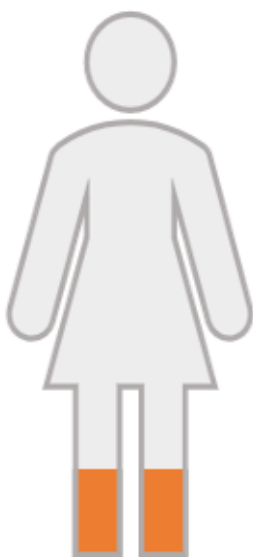

# Victims

In all incidents in September, the total number of victims was **81**. In the incidents for which the sex of the victims was reported, **63** were men and **14** were women.

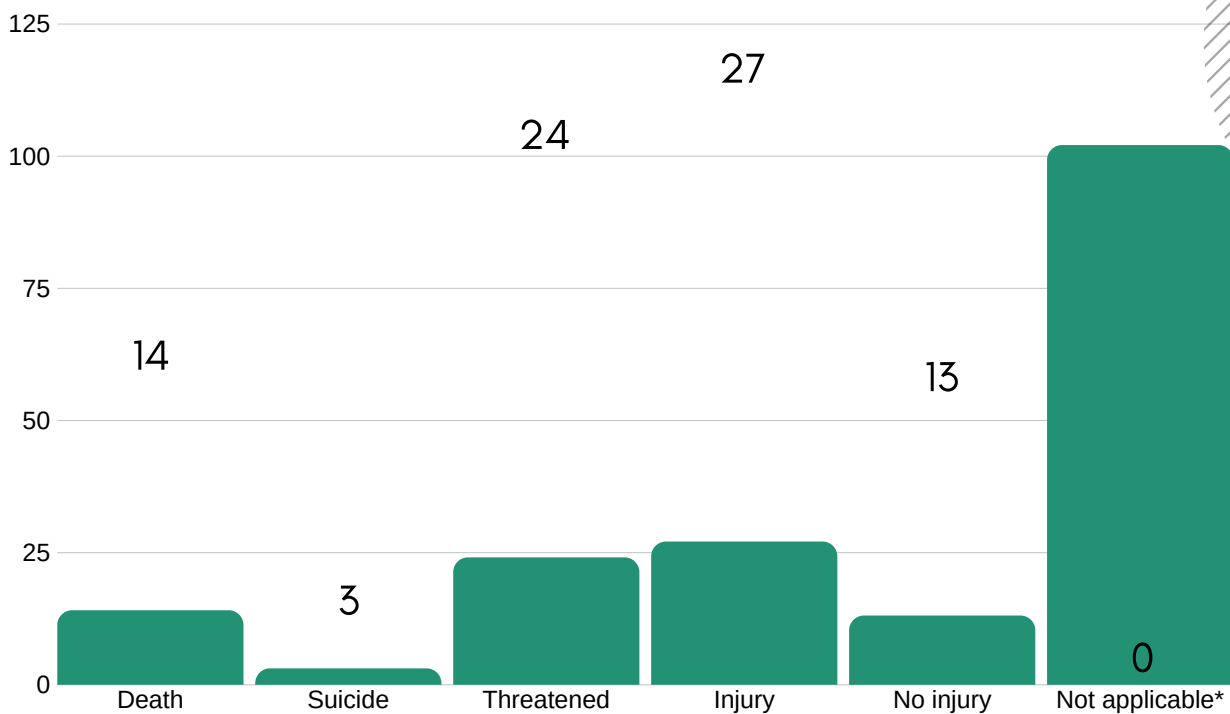

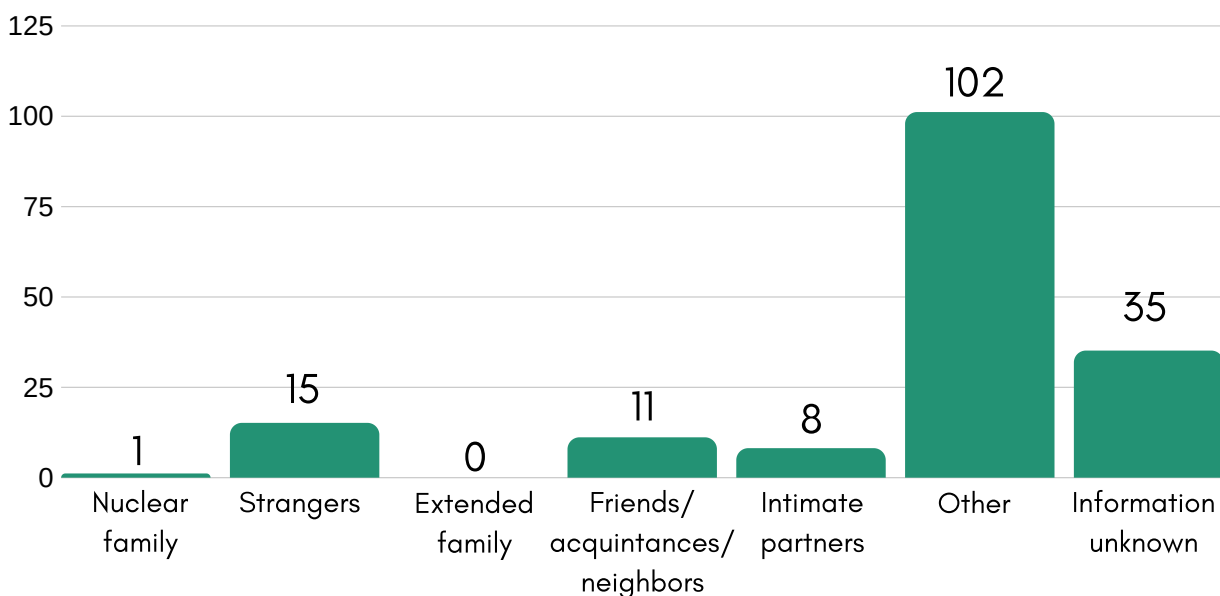
