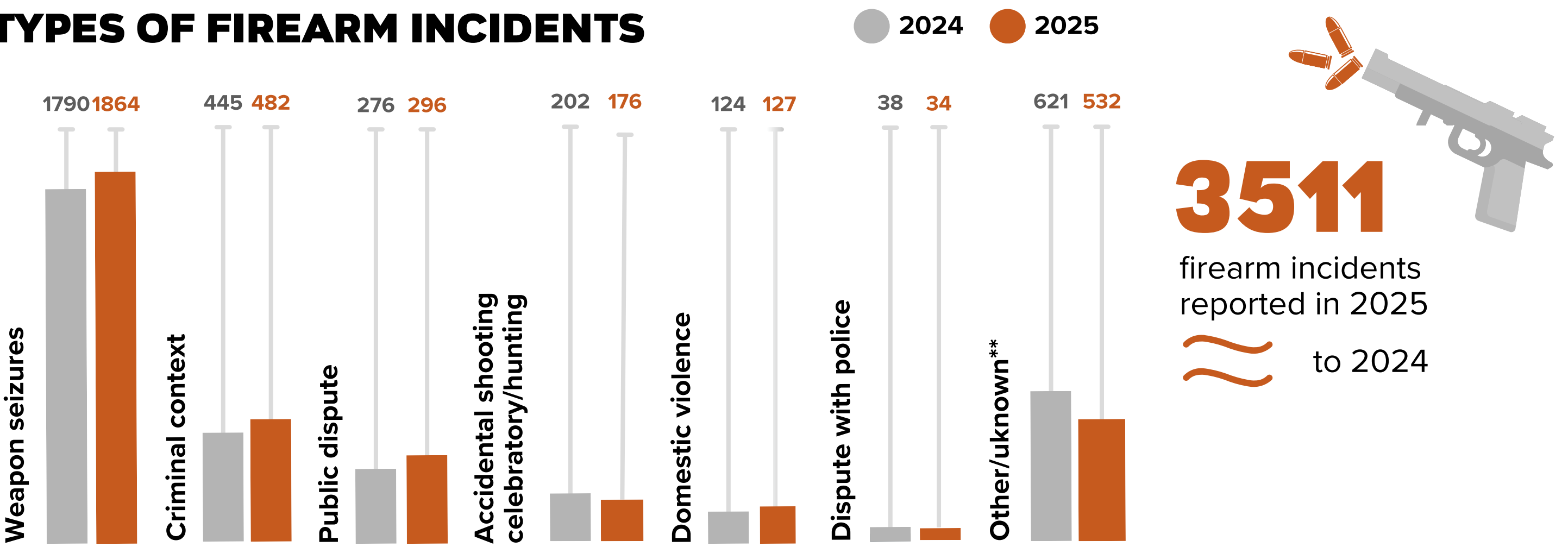

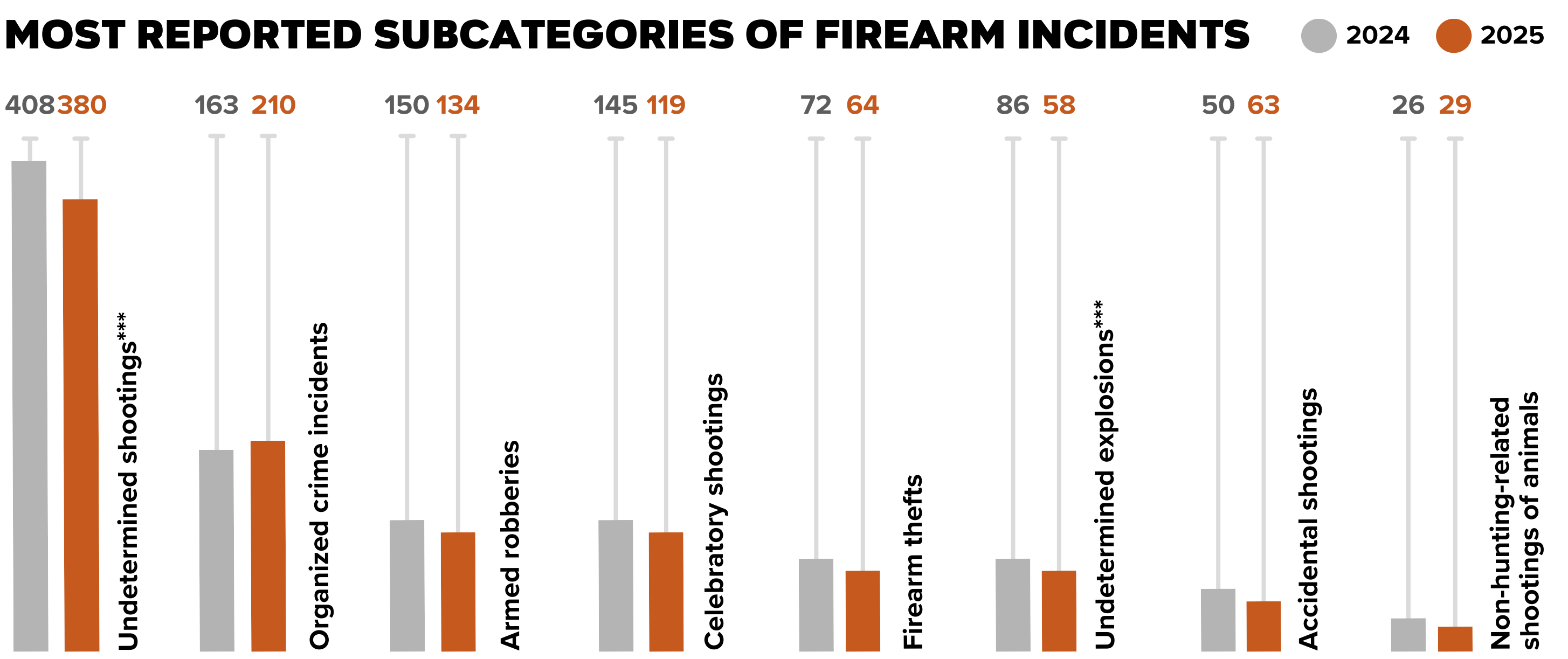

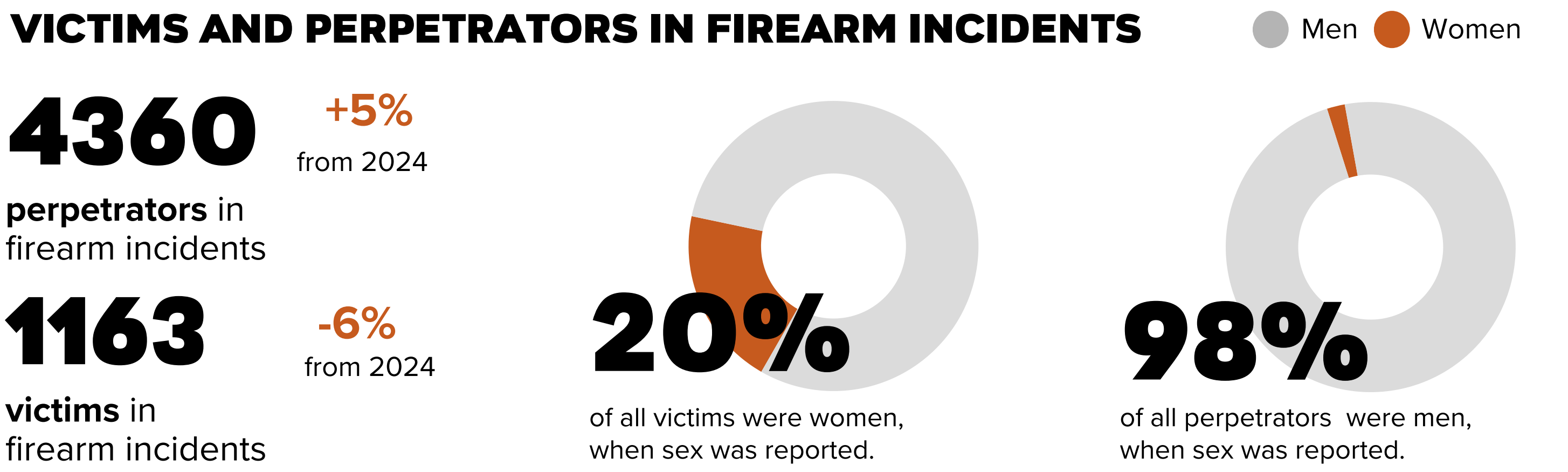
## TYPES OF FIREARM INCIDENTS



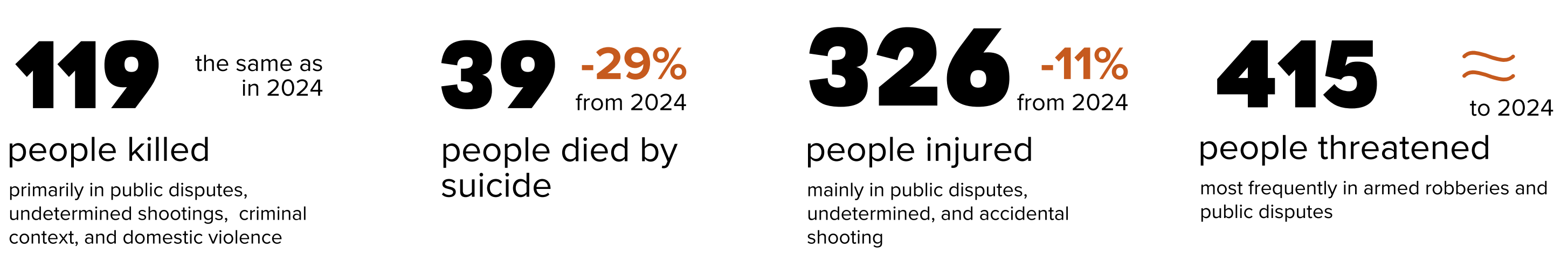
## MOST REPORTED SUBCATEGORIES OF FIREARM INCIDENTS



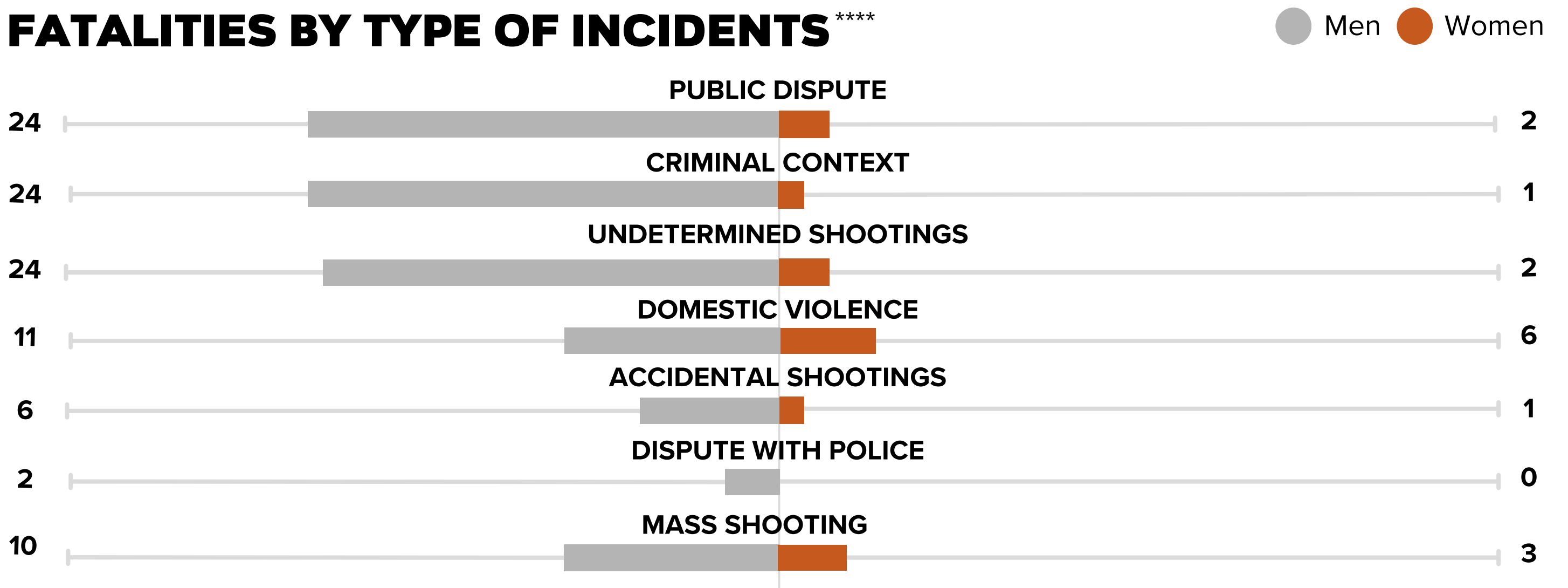

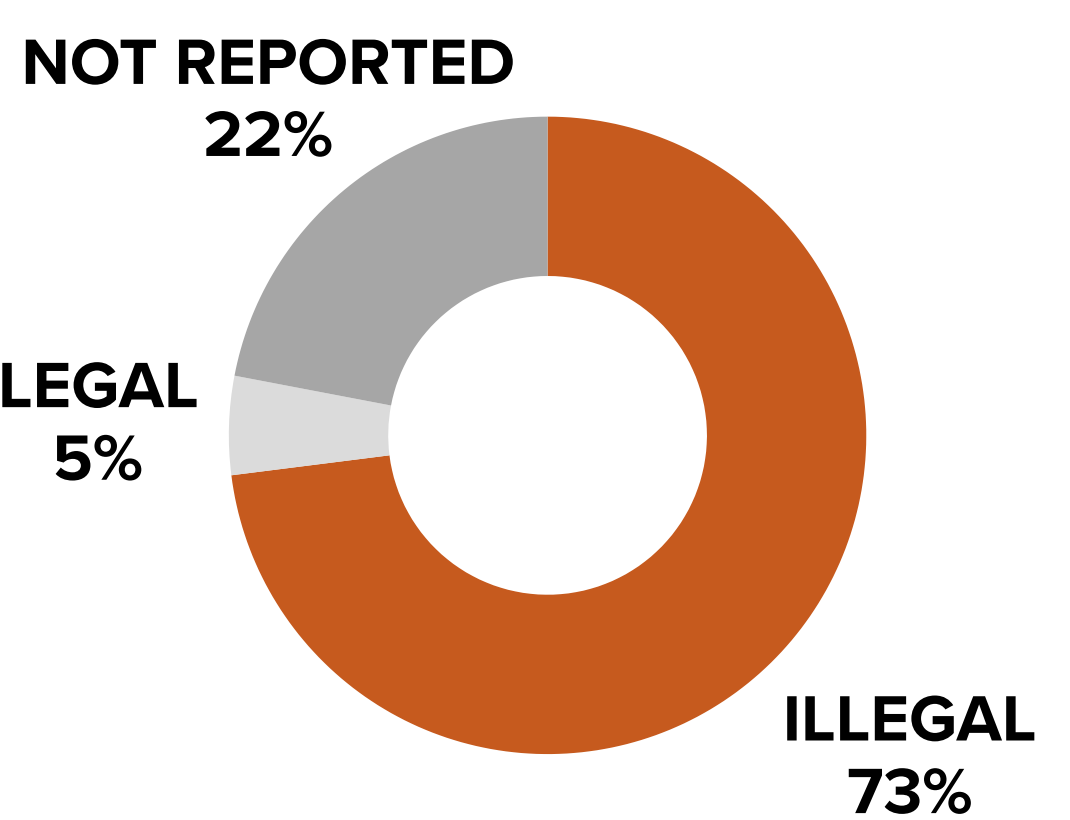


## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TRENDS

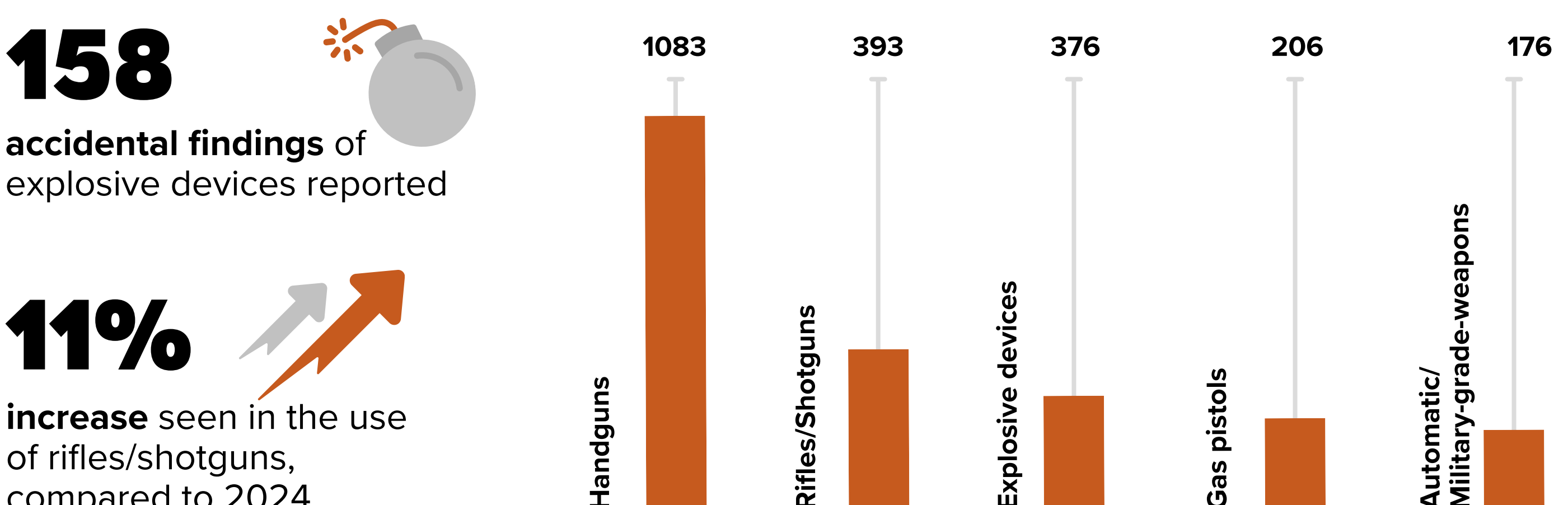
In 2025, domestic violence was no longer the leading context of firearm-related fatalities.

The higher share of fatalities in men arising from domestic settings observed in 2024 persisted.

\*The Armed Violence Monitoring Platform tracks firearm incidents in the Western Balkans and the Republic of Moldova.

\*\*Other/Unknown, as a separate category under the Types of Firearm incidents, refers to suicides, shootings under undetermined circumstances, non-hunting-related shooting of animals, undetermined explosions, weapons used for defence, and all other incidents that cannot be classified under any of the categories above.

\*\*\*Undetermined shootings refer to any firearm discharge under unknown circumstances and motives, regardless of whether or not such an incident caused damage, injury or fatality.

\*\*\*\* Data shown include only firearm-related fatalities for which information on the sex of the victim was available.
