

DECISION
No. 754, dated 9/12/2021

**ON THE APPROVAL OF THE ACTION PLAN 2022–2024 OF THE SMALL ARMS,
LIGHT WEAPONS, THEIR AMMUNITION AND EXPLOSIVES
CONTROL STRATEGY 2019-2024**

Pursuant to Article 100 of the Constitution, upon proposal of the Minister of Interior, the Council of Ministers

DECIDED:

1. The approval of the Action Plan 2022–2024 of the Small Arms, Light Weapons, their Ammunition and Explosives Control Strategy 2019-2024, pursuant to the text attached to this Decision and constituting an integral part thereof.

2. The Ministry of Interior, the Ministry of Defence, the Ministry of Justice, the Ministry of Finance and Economy, the Ministry of Education and Sport and the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs shall be in charge for the implementation of this Decision.

This Decision shall enter into force upon its publication in the Official Journal.

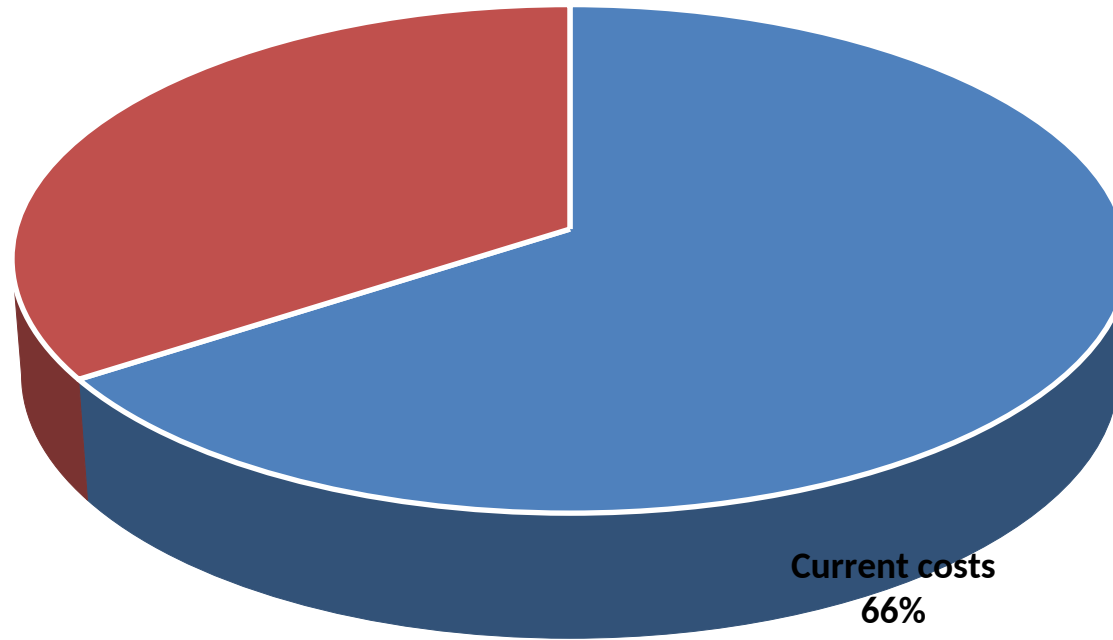

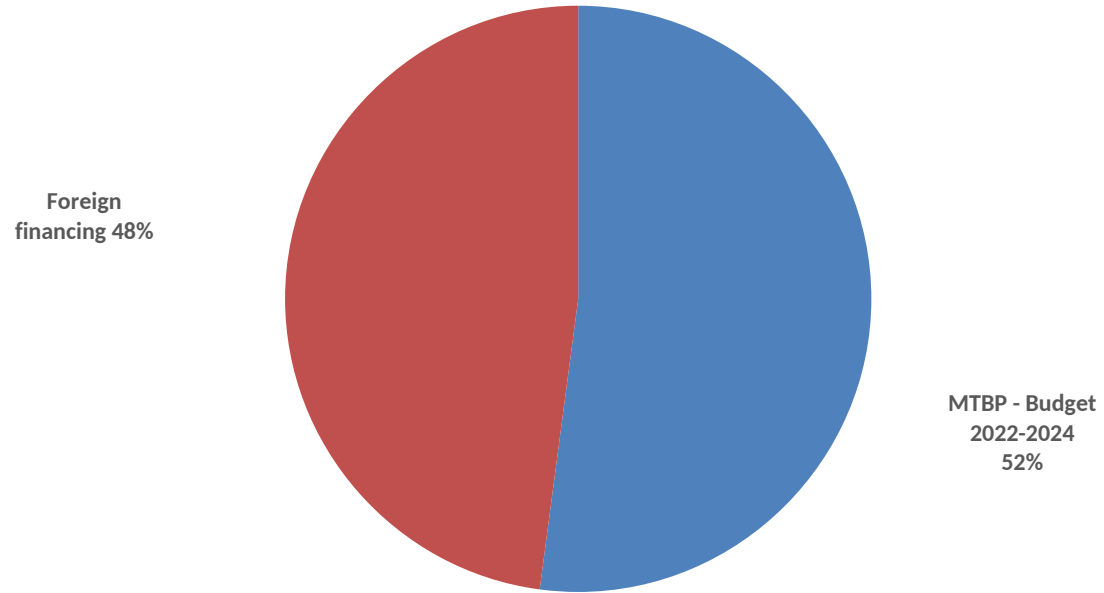
