**RULES OF PROCEDURE
ON THE CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS IN TERMS OF MATERIAL-TECHNICAL AND
IT EQUIPMENT OF THE PREMISES DESIGNATED FOR CONDUCTING THE WEAPON
LICENCE EXAM**

Article 1

This Rules of Procedure prescribe the criteria regarding the requirements in terms of material-technical and IT equipment of the premises designated for conducting the weapon licence exam (hereinafter: the exam).

Article 2

There are two examination rooms and each should be equipped with:

- at least 36 desks, out of which 30 for testing stations, five for the members of the exam commission and one for the server,
- at least 36 chairs,
- at least a 2x2 m big display for presenting the results,
- at least 30 PCs with at least a 19" Monitor,
- one central server with a display for monitoring the testing process and for local recoding of the testing process,
- local communication network,
- a network toggle, and
- a network camera to record the exam.

Article 3

The examination premises shall have an Internet connection of at least 10 MB/s, used strictly for online testing, as well as an access to the application of the Ministry of Internal Affairs for conducting the online exam.

Article 4

These Rules of Procedure shall enter into force on the eighth day following the date of publication in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia".
