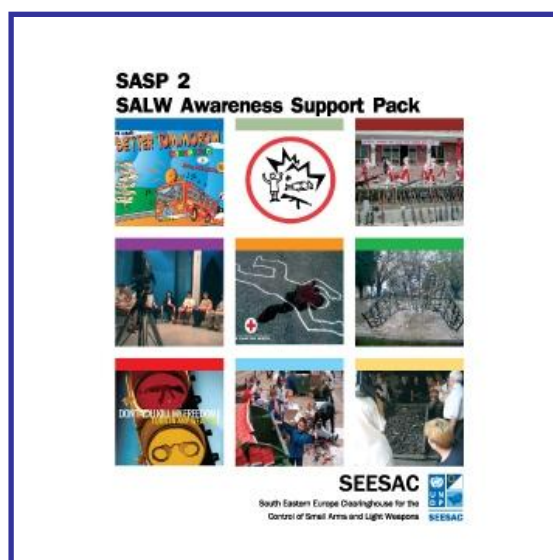

The SASP 2 CD-ROM has now been completely updated with a comprehensive selection of materials including: 1) the latest publications on the impact of SALW on development and humanitarian work; 2) useful resources on Communication Tools and Programming Aids; 3) operational support tools such as PowerPoint presentations on different aspects of SALW Control and SALW Risk Education materials for children; 4) Donor and Fundraising Materials; and 5) a number of example campaign materials.

Consisting of a Handbook and a CD-ROM, SASP 2 serves as a guide to SALW Awareness activities, primarily in support of SALW Control interventions and as part of stand-alone Risk Education. It guides the project manager step-by-step through the programme cycle and is supplemented by case studies drawn from SALW Awareness activities globally.
